

MatStats Installation

MatStats is a Windows executable program, built for the 64-bit operating system. If a 32-bit version is needed, please contact me via the contact page at burnsdigitalimaging.com

Software Files:

1. Download the *matstats* zip file from burnsdigitalimaging.com,
http://burnsdigitalimaging.com/Software/MatStats/matstats1v1_2015b.zip
2. The Matlab MCR file (2015b) available at,
http://www.mathworks.com/supportfiles/downloads/R2015b/deployment_files/R2015b/installers/win64/MCR_R2015b_win64_installer.exe
Download this (790 MB) file.

Installation:

You will need administrator rights to do this.

1. Install the MATLAB Compiler Runtime (MCR) on your computer. This needs to be for Matlab version 2015b. To do this, double-click on the MCR Installer file, MCRInstaller .exe. Installation will take a few minutes. I recommend that you answer with the default selections.
2. The executable file also needs the Microsoft Visual C++ 2010 Redistributable Package (x86) installed. This is available at
<http://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=5555>
3. Unzip *matstats.zip* and find *matstats* executable (.exe) file. Double-click or otherwise start. This may take a couple of minutes to start the first time. You may get a warning from your anti-virus software and a question whether you want to run the program. Answer yes.
4. If the program fails to start, you may need to install the Microsoft Visual C++ Redistributable for Visual Studio 2012 (x86), which can be found at,

When MatStats starts correctly you should see the console as follows.
